Craigholme B&B is an end terraced property located in Bowness-on-Windemere, Cumbria. The Bed & Breakfast offers three luxury bedrooms including a Guest Suite, Large Double and Standard Double rooms – each with their own private bathroom. The current owners purchased the property in 2013 for £297,000. Pleased with the results, the owner and their accountant have since referred multiple other business owners to Zeal.

🖉 Overview of the claim

After receiving an estimate of the tax savings concealed in the property, the owner requested that our team collaborated directly with her accountant to claim the capital allowances opportunity identified. As instructed, the accountant provided the necessary documents and tax returns.

The result

Due to COVID-19 travel restrictions at the time, a virtual survey of the building was completed to establish all eligible expenditure. Two days after survey completion, our tax team sent the findings and report to the owner and their accountant for approval. This was submitted to HMRC later the same day. Around £68k in qualifying allowances was found hidden within the B&B. The claim generated almost £20k in tax savings for the owner, including a cash rebate of £4k for overpaid tax. The owner's next tax bill was also completely eliminated.
